

**GREYSTONES LAWN TENNIS CLUB CODE OF CONDUCT FOR MEMBERS AND COURT USAGE  
MARCH 2018**

**All Members are required to abide by the following Code of Conduct.**

- Players should arrive on time for their game. All members should sign their names into court booking list prior to playing and have use of the court for one hour while other members are waiting
- Appropriate tennis attire including tennis shoes must be worn on court
- When parked and waiting in the car park, members should not leave their car engines running or headlights on as doing so causes a distraction for other players
- Players must show respect to fellow members and staff, refrain from the use of abusive language, and the use of mobile phone on court
- Chewing gum is forbidden in the club premises.
- Glassware and glass bottles are not permitted on the courts
- You should vacate your court when your time is up. You should leave the court tidy!
- Please only use one set of lights. Lights will only come on when its dark enough. If you wish to put on two sets of lights – please place the €10 fee in envelope and into post box on front office.

**The following should be noted:**

- Members are asked not to approach any Committee member on court to discuss any issue.
- Any member wishing to make a complaint must do so in writing (email) and send to the Honorary Secretary. [secretary@greystonesltc@gmail.com](mailto:secretary@greystonesltc@gmail.com)
- The Clubhouse is frequented by all age groups and it is important to be mindful not to cause offence by improper behaviour or bad language. The clubhouse has to adhere to the legislation relating to licensed premises and therefore Children are not permitted to be on premises after the legal hours.
- All complaint's involving alleged misconduct will be dealt with by the relevant Committee and if required a Disciplinary Committee will be formed to investigate the matter.

**The following is court usage priority :**

- Scheduled Open Tournaments have priority over all other games. Eg. Veterans, Senior and Junior
- DLTC scheduled league matches have priority over other games.
- Scheduled Club, Inter Club competitions and Social events up to a maximum of 9 courts
- Monday night social tennis courts 1-6 with overflow 10-12
- Scheduled club coaching approved by committee. Courts 1-9 available for Junior Coaching Monday – Friday during hours 14.30 – 19.30
- Juniors after 19.30 for special coaching squads only.
- Seniors from 19.30 onwards
- Juniors playing on Senior League teams have equal status as Seniors.

**The undertaking to be a member in GLTC is deemed to be agreement on the part of the member to abide by this Code of Conduct.**
